



Saint Timothy's will be participating again in several Christmas outreach programs through the Salvation Army and Signal Mountain Social Services.

The Salvation Army offers Angels for children, backpacks for the homeless, and stockings for the elderly. Parishioners can adopt any number and combination of Angels, backpacks, and stockings by signing up at the Salvation Army Table. The Salvation Army will provide the backpacks and stockings, and a list of suggested items with which to fill them will be available on the table. The Angels will list the gender and age of the child, along with the child's "Wish List" and clothing sizes. Parishioner signups will take place from October 27 through November 7. The actual backpacks, stockings and Angels will be available for pickup November 9. Filled backpacks and stockings are due by November 27, and the Angels are due December 5.
